Tentage/Fly: Bring Dog tents

Special Instructions: UOD

Hat: Issue forage caps preferred, Commercial US kepi, Black civilian hats (in limited numbers)

Whatever you choose, you should have at least a blue 3rd Division, III Corps badge (Diamond)

Coat: Lined or unlined issue sack coat preferred Commercial sack coat NY State jackets (in limited numbers) NCOs should have appropriate rank attached

Trousers: SA or Contract trousers in sky blue only

Shirts: Wool flannel contract issue shirt, Domet flannel US issue shirt, Properly constructed civilian shirt

Drawers: US issue canton flannel drawers Civilian drawers

Footwear: US issue brogans, appropriate civilian shoes (no camp shoes), Civilian boots

AOP gaiters in limited numbers (only the lace-up AOP gaiters, no Zouave styles, black painted ones, erdan leather gaiters, etc.)

Leathers: US belt with leather or brass keeper, US issue cap pouch, Cartridge box on sling with both box and belt plates, Appropriate painted cloth US haversack with mess gear 2-rivet or sewn bayonet scabbard preferred
