Event: 3rd USV - 14th Connecticut at Gettysburg **Date:** Jul 1-2, 2023 ---Be there before 8.00 am Saturday

Location: Spangler Farm, 488 Blacksmith Shop Rd, Gettysburg, PA 17325

Description: This is a living history emersion event portraying the 14th Connecticut on the Spangler Farm hospital site. This will be more of a day in the life of the soldier complete with campsite, drilling and interaction with spectators.

Threats/Safety: Normal hazards to include dehydration, sun exposure (water, sunscreen,) tick and insects (repellant advised). There will be no firing demonstration but make sure you arms are secure at all times per NSPS regulations.

Water: Available, Bring full canteens!

Campfires: Yes, details TBD

Firewood: Provided

Food: There will be company mess on Saturday and Sunday. Bring Hardtack, and period rations along with personnel food stuffs

Other: Very simple breakfast on Saturday; our normal breakfast Saturday; "issued" lunches both days; Stew Saturday Night - bring any additional you may desire.

Personnel

UOD/Impression: Standard mid war (1863) uniform. Kevi/Forage cap/sack coat/sky blue trousers. Corp badge will be issue at registration

Arms: 3-band rifles (Enfield, Springfield) w/NO rounds

Dog tents / Shelter tents only. Do not bring A-frames

Other: Please bring tin cups, plates/bowls, and silverware, and poke sacks for ration issue

Reporting Instructions. Participants should arrive no later than 8AM on Saturday 1 July. This said, attendees may arrive as early as Thursday 29 June. (Any program on Friday 30 June will be organized around any on hand.)

Signing In: See Kyle Windahl at the Regt Hq on arrival to check in and get your Corps Badge. If you haven't paid your event fee (\$10) yet, settle with Kyle.

Main program is Saturday and Sunday 1 and 2 July, between the hours of 10 and 4 pm. Note that the site closes at 4 PM - special arrangements needed for arrival after hours. (Regt Hq will have gate access code.)
